

Bulking up

Since it began operations in 2004, **Tremcar** has expanded multiple times in the village of Strasburg, Ohio. Founded in 1962 in Quebec, Canada this tank trailer and tank truck manufacturer has a strong record of adapting to market conditions. The company announced up to 30 new positions and a \$4 million expansion to upgrade technology and increase production capacity in Strasburg. In addition to new production lines the company is adding more space to its service and repair operations to keep their in-demand stainless steel and aluminum tank trailers rolling along the bulk product supply chains of North America.

Predictions of future expansion for **Magna Seating Columbus**, which got its start in 2019, have come true.
The company's initial \$60 million investment received a boost of \$6 million in 2022 in order to expand production of seat structures for the automotive industry. The investment will boost economic activity in the region, adding over 200 workers to the 390 existing jobs in Lancaster. This is just one of five operations the Canadian-owned Magna has in the Buckeye State. In total, Magna employs approximately 2,700 Ohioans.


Building a new legacy

In early 2023, Québec-based **Victoriaville & Co.** chose the Bellaire-Puritas neighborhood in southwest Cleveland to establish a new manufacturing facility. The hardwood casket maker expects to create as many as 100 jobs as it invests over \$1.1 million in a 67,000-square-foot facility. In announcing the new operation, the company cited the advantages of simplified supply chains among the reasons why the Ohio location was selected.
